**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PARSIPPANY-TROY HILLS
IN SUPPORT OF SEPTEMBER 11 OBSERVANCES**

WHEREAS, four years have passed since the terrorist attack of September 11, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council of Parsippany-Troy Hills wishes to declare September 11 as a day of observance and remembrance of the events of September 11, 2001; and

WHEREAS the Township Council believes that celebrations, such as parades and picnics, are inappropriate for this day of observance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Council does hereby establish September 11 as a day of observance for the events that occurred on September 11, 2001.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township Council seeks to encourage the residents of the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills to observe that day without celebrations, parades or picnics.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills shall observe September 11 and its anniversary and shall not schedule any of its own celebrations, parades, picnics, etc. for that day.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the representatives of the 26th Legislative District and the Morris County Board of Chosen Freeholders.
